Rancho Cal Arab Horse Assoc- March 28-31, April 7 ODS at Green Acres. Sept 29 at Galway.

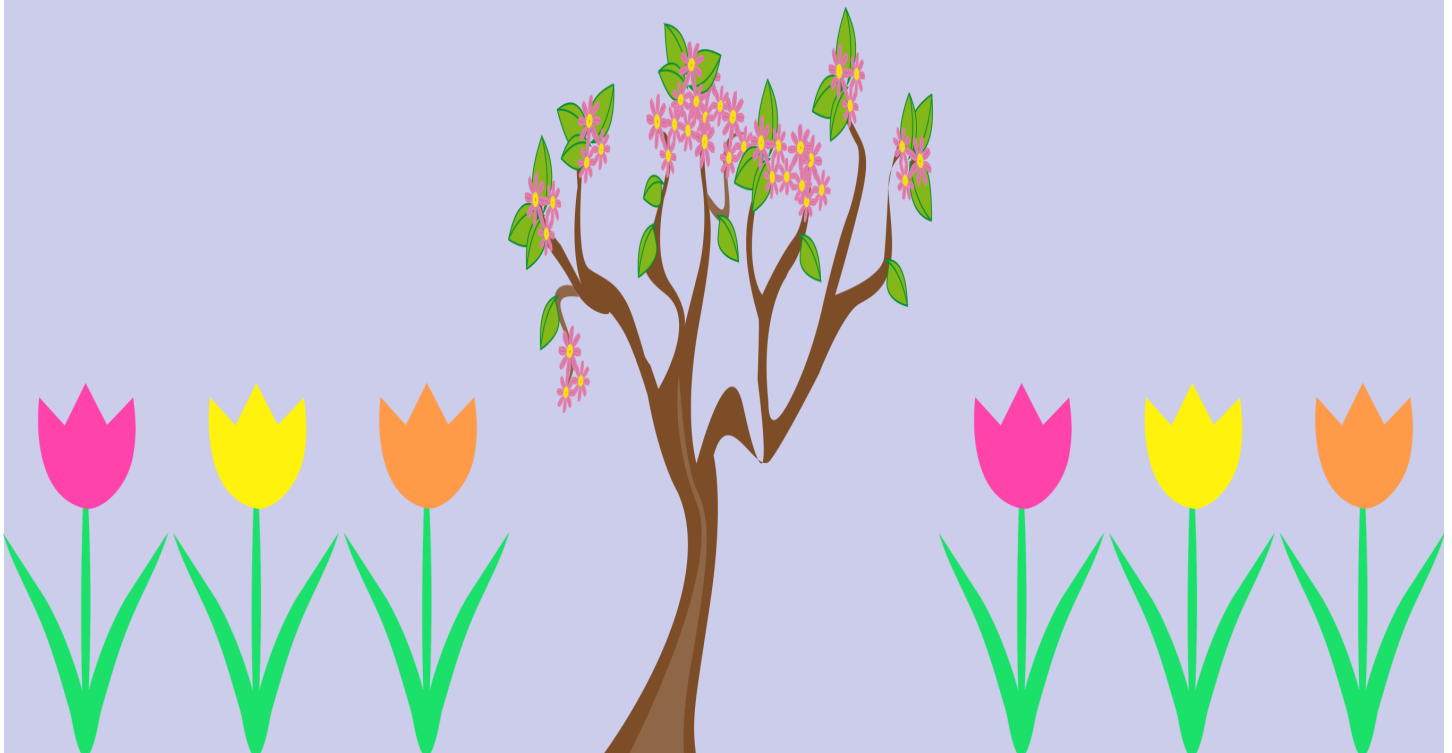

- 25% upon involvement in the Arabian industry

- 50% upon grade point average. **Official Transcripts Required**

- 10% upon the essay each applicant must submit with their application

- 5% upon extracurricular equine activities

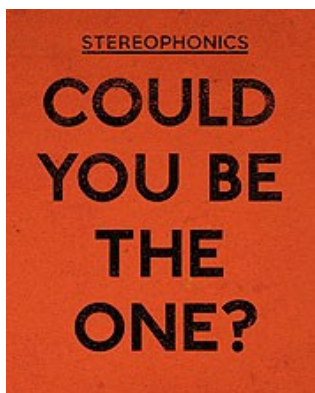
- 5% upon extracurricular school &/or community activities

- 5% upon personal references


Scholarships are awarded annually, preceding the school year for which they must be used.

Upon notification of enrollment, a check from the scholarship fund will be sent to the college/university by Region One to be applied to educational expenses in the recipient's behalf.




REGION ONE SCHOLARSHIP

EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

ALL APPLICATIONS DUE ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 2019

Please read the following information carefully and submit all the necessary requirements



Each year Region One awards educational scholarships to deserving students.
Applicants must be members of an AHA club in Region One.

Scholarship applicants will be selected on the basis of academic ability, financial need, leadership, and equine activities.

Each applicant must submit three (3) letters of recommendation with their application. Required letters include:

- one (1) letter from an officer of an AHA club
- one (1) letter from a 4-H club, FFA club, civic/community leader, or school club advisor
- one (1) letter from the applicant's high school principal counselor, or college/university faculty member



Applicants must submit an **Official** high school or college transcript. An official transcript can be obtained through your university/college in the registrars office, or ordered online.

Copies of official ACT, SAT, or similar college entrance exam results must be attached for High School applicants.

Each application is carefully reviewed by the Scholarship Committee of Region One. Applications are evaluated based on the following criteria: 25% based upon involvement in the Arabian industry, 50% based upon grade point average, 10% based upon the essay. (Each applicant must submit an essay with their application on why they feel they deserve a scholarship), 10% based upon extra curricular equine activities, 5% based upon extra curricular school and community activities.

Scholarships are awarded annually, preceding the school year for which they must be used. Upon notification of enrollment, a check from the scholarship fund will be sent to the college/university by Region One to be applied to educational expenses in the recipient's behalf.

INFORMATION NEEDED FOR APPLICATION

1. The application must be made on an official application form and must be filled out and signed by the person applying for the scholarship
 2. An **Official** grade transcript from the applicant's most recent high school or college/university must accompany the application
 3. Additional information may also be attached. The application becomes the property of the Region One Scholarship Committee and cannot be returned.
 4. Scholarship selection is based on scholastic aptitude, involvement in the Arabian industry, leadership potential, sportsmanship, extra curricular activities, and personal references.
 5. In order to apply for this scholarship, the applicant must hold a high school diploma or equivalent certification, or must be anticipating high school graduation this year. GPA must be at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale or a 3.8 on a 6.0 scale.
 6. ***It is to each applicant's advantage to submit a very complete, neat and informative application.***
 7. A copy of your official ACT, SAT, or similar exam results must be attached.
 8. A current picture must accompany this application.

REGION 1 SCHOLARSHIP CHECKLIST

After gathering all of your required items and completing your scholarship application, please review your package with this checklist.

CHECK OFF AND SIGN this check list to show that you understand and are completely sure that the required items are contained in your scholarship package. Include this checklist with your application package.

- **Official application** form COMPLETELY and CORRECTLY filled out. (No places should have the words “see attached” for information that is asked for on the application)
- **OFFICIAL UNIVERSITY/COLLEGE TRANSCRIPTS** – Official transcripts can be ordered from your college or university, and come in sealed (DO NOT OPEN) envelopes with the university seal or stamp/signature on them. **High School** students can get official transcripts at the school office but they still need to be sealed, and signed or have a seal on the envelope. Your high school knows how to do this...they do it all the time.
- **3 Letters of Recommendation** – Recommendation letters are usually on the person’s letterhead stationary and is not a printed off email. A person might send you a letter in a document form with their letterhead as an attachment to an email that you can print off as well. Usually, they are simply handed to the person that has asked for the recommendation. (please see the application for instructions on the requirements of who you need recommendation letters from)
- **For High School students:** A copy of ACT/SAT, or similar exam results must be attached. DO NOT JUST WRITE THE SCORE IN. YOU HAVE TO HAVE A COPY OF THE RESULTS ATTACHED AS WELL.
- A **current photograph** must accompany the application

My signature on this page is to ensure that I have read and filled out the Region 1 scholarship application according to the requirements on the application. Also, I have included each of the items listed above in their correct format. I understand that it is my responsibility to read and be aware of all of the requirements on the Official Region 1 Scholarship application. 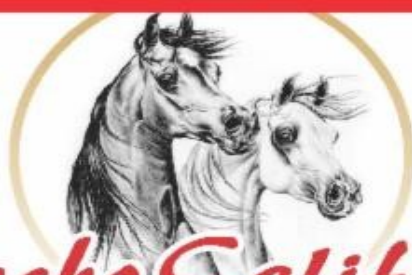
