#### **Making Cookies for Your Horse!!**



#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 1 cup uncooked oatmeal
- 1 cup flour
- 1 cup shredded carrots
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 ½ tablespoons sugar
- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil
- ½ cup water

#### **DIRECTIONS**

- Mix all ingredients in bowl in order listed.
- Make small or medium size balls out of mixture and place on a cookie sheet sprayed with Pam.
- For extra happy horses you can sprinkle a little crushed peppermint on them before baking.
- Bake at 350°F for 15-20 minutes and make sure they don't burn!
