PLEASE TAKE NOTICE OF REQUIREMENTS FROM USEF

MOTORIZED VEHICLES - Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds.

Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

REGION ONE WILL BE FOLLOWING THE VACCINATION RULE GR844

SHARPS CONTAINERS — GR1210.4 REQUIREMENT

4. Competition management must place a minimum of one (1) sharps container per competition, regardless of whether stabling is provided.

a. If stabling is provided, for every fifty (50) occupied stalls, one (1) sharps container must be provided for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments. These containers must be placed in visible, accessible, and convenient locations in barns housing competition horses.

b. Sharps Containers: A sharps container is made of puncture-resistant plastic with leak-resistant sides and bottom. It has a tight fitting, puncture resistant lid, which does not allow sharps to come out of the container. Sharps containers must be properly labeled to warn of hazardous waste inside the container. Sharps containers must not be altered in any way from its manufactured form, such as removal of security measures or drilling of the plastic. Sharps containers must be protected from the elements as to not collect rainwater

c. It is competition management's responsibility to dispose of contents of sharps containers when the container is three-quarters (3/4) full, in accordance with community guidelines for proper disposal methods. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100.00 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

d. If local law has more stringent requirements than the above, related to sharps containers or disposal, local law will prevail. Competitions that fail to place the required number of containers on the competition grounds or dispose of the contents properly will be considered in violation of the rules and may be subject to penalty as determined by the CEO or their designee and/or the Hearing Committee.

USEF SHOW PASSES - Eligible exhibitors are prohibited from obtaining more than one (1) Show Pass per competition year. BOD 9/26/22 Effective 12/1/22. Show Passes must be purchased online at USEF.ORG

ENTRY FORM CHECK LIST

ENTRIES

Entries must be submitted on the official entry form for this show. Entries on thermal FAX paper are NOT acceptable. Please print clearly and legibly or use a typewriter to complete the entry form. If additional forms are required please download from aharegionone.com or make photocopies (of both sides) or request them from the Show Secretary.

All horses belonging to one owner must be entered together. No horse may be entered on more than one entry form. The complete name and address of the registered owner must appear in the "Owner" space. One, and only one, owner can appear on each entry form.

Farm name may not be used unless (1) the stable or farm is the bona fide owner on the horse's papers or (2) the stable or farm name has been registered with USEF (see Article 815) and the number shown on the USEF farm certificate is included in the space provided. If a farm name is used as Owner, the farm must have an AHA Business membership and that Business membership number must be used as the Owner AHA number. A copy of the Business membership card must accompany the entry.

If farm/business/trust-owned horses are shown in Amateur-Owner classes, the USEF farm registration certificate showing names of all the owners of the farm must be included with the entry and all owners of the farm must be members of the immediate family.

If an exhibitor is buying the horse on contract, the buyer may be shown as owner on the entry form, a copy of the contract must be submitted with the entry as proof of ownership. Reminder: horses entered in **AO** classes must have registration papers showing the rider/handler or a member of the exhibitor's family as recorded owners of the horse.

Owner, (or agent), trainer and all riders/drivers/handlers/coaches must sign entry form in the spaces provided. If owner is the trainer, owner must sign on both owner and trainer spaces. (Trainer is "any adult who has the responsibility for the care, training, custody or performance of a horse"). Parent or guardian must sign for junior exhibitor in space provided on back of entry form.

After completing the entry form, mail it together with the following to the address listed below:

- a check (not post-dated) for all fees and charges (credit cards accepted)
- a copy of both sides of the registration papers for ALL horses entered.
- a copy of the AHA/USEF/USDF/WDAA membership cards for owner, trainer and all riders

ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE IN AOTR, AAOTR, JOTR CLASSES - Horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must be registered in the name of the competitors or a member of the competitor's family, as defined by USEF GR 122. (Horses registered in a farm/ranch/syndicate/partnership/corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the arm or entity as defined by USEF GR 122.) The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted. Horses must be qualified by an amateur owner.

After May 28th, DOUBLE class fee post entry penalties will apply for all classes until 5:00 pm on the day preceding the class to be entered. Any entry which is shown in a class in which it was not properly entered will be charged TRIPLE the class entry fee. To be properly entered, the class must have been listed on the original entry form or on a properly submitted ADD-A-CLASS form in the horse show office prior to the class in question. If the class ridden without prior entry is a Championship class for which the entry was not qualified, the TRIPLE entry fee must still be paid.

TABLE INFORMATION

STABLING

There are 788 matted stalls 12X12 and 12X10 matted 10x12 with sliding yoke doors. No temporary equipment may be permanently attached to any existing property such as signs, barricades, stabling, trees, etc. **ANY EARLY ARRIVALS OR LATE DEPARTURES MUST BE APPROVED BY THE SHOW MANAGER RICH WHITLEY.**

NOTE FOR SETUP AND TEARDOWN All barn displays must be completely cleaned up and sod, dirt, shavings removed from front of barn and aisle areas or the farm will be billed back all charges associated with the clean-up of barn display. Excess garbage and building material left on the show grounds that needs to be cleaned up, any and all charges billed to Region 1 will be billed back to exhibitor. Failure to comply may result in an addition fine.

STABLE ASSIGNMENT POLICY

Barn assignments are subject to annual review of the Show Commission. The Show Commission has ultimate discretion in determination of barn assignments. Some of the criteria used to determine barn assignments are number of years of participation, degree of support and number of horses. Region One has adopted a barn assignment policy that favors those farms and/or exhibitors who have maintained a high level of support. Exhibitors requesting specific barn locations please note the following:

Exhibitors wishing to be stabled together must submit their entries together in the same envelope. If you have any special stabling requests or considerations, submit them on a separate sheet with the entry. There will be a charge of \$75/day for the use of any stall or tack room by anyone other than the exhibitor assigned to same. Assignment of stalls is entirely at the discretion of show management. Horses must be placed in stalls assigned and no changes will be permitted without the express consent of the Barn Manager. Exhibitors must notify the barn manager of any changes in stabling. Every horse in a stall **MUST** be entered in the show.

TRAILER PARKING AREAS - Specific areas have been set aside for parking of horse trailers and vans of exhibitors reserving stalls. Special parking areas will be available for exhibitors showing from trailers. Motor-bikes and motorcycles are prohibited on the fairgrounds. Because parking is limited in the barn area, exhibitors will be issued a limited number of parking permits for the stable area. Overflow exhibitor vehicles may be parked in the paved parking lot on the south side of the horse show arena (2nd gate off Jimmy Durante Blvd.) Fire regulations prohibit parking between the barns.

RV SPACE RESERVATIONS

All Reservations and payment for RV or Motor Home space **MUST** be made payable to Region I Arabian Horse Show call Rich Whitley at 619-884-4786 or email - rwhitley101@gmail.com.

ADMISSION TO THE RING - No person will be permitted to enter the ring except participants in the class, judges, their assistants and show officials. Attendants and grooms may enter the ring only when summoned by order of the judge. In all cases requiring attendants in the ring, proper attire is required.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT - Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association recognized Arabian Division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA membership/competition card. Join AHA or pay an AHA single event membership fee per competitor. When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the owner and agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA single event membership. Single event membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National competitions. Exhibitors in walk/trot classes are exempt from AHA membership requirements at qualifying competitions, but must have an AHA membership with a competition card at AHA Regional and National competitions. Exhibitors in lead line classes or parents/guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA membership requirements. (BOD 5/12).

POST ENTRIES ALLOWED WITH PENALTY

AMATEUR - AMATEUR CERTIFICATION - Only active Federation members may obtain amateur status. Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur status issued by the Federation. (Exception: This is not required for Opportunity classes). This status must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the competition secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such status provided by the Federation. Amateur status will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. Foreign riders requesting Federation Amateur status, must be a Junior, Senior or Life Competing Member of the Federation (Exception: Equine Canada members in possession of current EC membership may sign for USEF Amateur status on a show by show basis at no cost). Any person who has not reached his/her 18th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur status. 2. An amateur continues to be such until he/she has received a change in status from the Federation. Any amateur who wishes to be re-classified on the grounds that he/she has engaged or is planning on engaging in activities which would prevent him/her from continuing to remain an amateur must notify the Federation in writing. 3. There is no fee for amateur status for Senior Active or Life Members. Such status will expire on November 30th.

FOOTING/ARENAS: All competition arenas and designated competition warm-up rings will be geotextile (GGT) mix footing with ebb and flow drainage. Exception working western will be held in arena with sand, shavings and dirt for footing.

CANCELLATION OF ENTRY

To encourage early entries, the Management agrees to cancel and refund entry, stall and all fees on any horse not fit to show providing written or email notification regiononeshowsecretary@gmail.com is given to the Show Secretary on or before entry closing date. Exhibitors canceling their entries for any reason after the official entry closing date shall forfeit all fees, except if a horse is scratched prior to May 6 by written communication to the show secretary, stall fees minus a \$25 handling fee will be refunded and tack/groom room fees will be refunded. No substitution of horses will be permitted except as provided in USEF Article 1506.2. Absolutely no requests for refunds for ANY reasons will be considered unless such written request with supporting documentation is in the show secretary's hand PRIOR to the show. No exhibitor may withdraw horses from the show after it has commenced, or remove them from the grounds, without the permission of the show manager.

CLASS CALLS - Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to be sure that his horse is at the gate at it's prescribed time. Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system to carry class calls; however, no protest will be upheld, nor will any class be changed on the basis of PA malfunction alone.

DISCIPLINE - Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy to the officials of this show on the part of the owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, or driver will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove a horse owner, lessee, trainer, groom or rider from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

DISQUALIFICATION - Any horse doctored in any way, artificially, improperly, or unfairly prepared or tampered with before entering the show arena will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made, or caused to be made a false statement in regard to any animal or article exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judges in the performance of their duties, he or she shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting.

DOGS - The State Humane Officer requires dogs to be confined or on a leash at all times and are not allowed outside the barn area. Dogs are NOT ALLOWED in the MAIN ARENA or show office area at any time.

DRUGS AND MEDICATIONS - The State of California and USEF requires that both halter and performance horses entering any show offering prize money will be charged a USEF drug testing fee of \$15.00 and a California drug testing fee of \$14 to help defray the expense of testing. USEF and California rules regarding drugs and medications will be enforced. In addition, an \$8 USEF fee must be charged for each horse entered.

DIRECTIONS: The Del Mar Horsepark is located 20 miles north of downtown San Diego, at 14550 El Camino Real in the city of Del Mar, California. From Interstate 5 take the Via de la Valle exit and head east (a right turn from the freeway exit if you are north bound; a left turn from the freeway exit if you are south bound). Take Via de la Valle to El Camino Real and turn right. Turn right at the second entrance past Mary's Tack and Feed. From Interstate 15 exit Valley Center Parkway and drive west continue on Del Dios Highway to El Camino Real and turn left. Turn right at the second entrance past Mary's Tack and Feed.

HEADERS - In all classes requiring grooms or other assistants, proper attire is required.

REGIONAL SHOW SCORING AND PLACING

Top Five Awards will be given regardless of the number of entries in a class. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed five awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes payout, AHA horse achievement awards, amateur achievement awards, high point horse achievement awards, high point amateur achievement awards.

FAILURE TO CANCEL CLASSES OR COMPLETE RIDER CHANGE FORMS - A rider change form must be completed in the show office or via the virtual show office, before the start of the session for any change from rider/handler listed on the entry. All riders/handlers and their member numbers must be reported to AHA for qualification and awards tracking. Exhibitors are required to complete an official scratch form prior to the class for all scratches. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to advise the show office of rider changes or scratches prior to a class; failure to complete rider change or scratch forms prior to the class will result in a \$25 fine and that horse, owner and rider-handler may not show in subsequent classes until the fine is paid at the show office. This courtesy will enable gatemen and the office to function efficiently.

FARRIER AND VETERINARIAN - A qualified farrier will be available on the grounds, Wednesday May 18 and thereafter throughout the show. An exhibitor may arrange an appointment with the farrier on Tuesday May 17 by contacting him directly, as early as possible. Management will employ a California licensed equine veterinarian as the official show veterinarian. Show management reserves the right to refuse entry onto the show grounds to any horse exposed to, or which may be harboring a communicable disease. All animals are subject to a physical inspection by the Official Show Veterinarian.

GOLF CARTS - A limited number of golf carts will be available for rent during the show week, please email the show secretary — email Nancy at regiononeshowsecretary@gmail.com. First come first served.

IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS - Every horse entered in the show will be assigned a separate identification number. It is important for the proper handling of the show that the correct number be worn by the rider or handler in all classes.

INDEMNITY AND NON-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSES

All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Region One of AHA, AHA and 22nd Agricultural District, HITS LLC & HITS Del Mar Leasing not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by an animal owned or exhibited, and shall indemnify the Region 1 of AHA, AHA and 22nd Agricultural District, HITS LLC & HITS Del Mar Leasing against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.

JUDGES - If for any reason a judge fails to attend this show or perform his/her duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one who is officially designated in the Prize List. It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive and/or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging. No one shall approach a judge with regard to a decision or at any time unless he first obtains permission from the Show Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place.

LOCATION OF CLASSES - Show management reserves the right to hold classes, or portions of classes, on the grounds outside the Main Arena if it is found necessary to do so, or to change and/or modify the Schedule of Events as necessary to accommodate the entries received.

LUNGEING: In designated areas only.

PRIZE MONEY - All Sweepstakes prize money will be distributed by the AHA office at the end of the year.

Paddock Area Conduct - There shall be no conduct in the paddock area which disturbs or creates a hazard to horses or handlers. There will be no whips, noise-makers or other equipment, devices, or objects allowed in the paddock area which might disturb or create a hazard to horses or handlers in the area, except the show whip properly carried by a handler in the paddock area.

PROTESTS - Should any questions or disputes arise, they must be protested in the manner prescribed by USEF Chapter 6.

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES - The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entries of any exhibitors, as stated in USEF GR913.

**A TOP FIVE QUALIFIES FOR NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS
A QUALIFYING SHOW FOR ALL 2025 & 2026 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP SHOWS**

REGION ONE CHAMPIONSHIP JUDGING SYSTEM - All Regional Championship Shows are required to use the AHA approved Majority Opinion System (MOS) scoring program in all applicable breeding/In-hand halter, performance and equitation classes. Regional Championship Dressage, Sport Horse, Trail, Reining and Reining Seat equitation classes will utilize a single judge system. In Reining and Trail horse classes, the score given by the judge will be announced prior to the work of the subsequent horses. Ties for Champion, Reserve Champion and fifth in a Top Five will be worked off using the same pattern, order of go and scoring techniques as was used in the class. If a tie still persists, the judge will be requested to rank the tied horses without further work-offs. In the case of a tie in a Dressage class, the judge shall determine the winner.

REGIONAL SHOW SCORING AND PLACING - Top Five Awards will be given regardless of the number of entries in a class. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed five awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes pay out, AHA horse achievement awards, amateur achievement awards, high point horse achievement awards, high point amateur achievement awards.

REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS - It is the responsibility of the person(s) signing the entry form to verify that the horse is eligible to be entered and compete in the Regional Championship class. No refunds will be made for horses improperly entered in Regional Championship or Sweepstakes classes. Exhibitors entering Regional Championship classes must include a copy of the horse's competition record from AHA or complete the qualification section on the front of the entry form. Qualifying data must be complete - including show name and date, qualifying class name, placing in the class, name of rider in qualifying class for ATR, JTR, AAOTR, JOTR, AOTR classes, and number of horses in the qualifying class.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS - Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association Inc., and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry, or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name. (Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers).

Horses shown in the HA/AA section must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association (AHA) in the Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian Registry, or have been issued an AHA (Canadian Partbred Arabian Register). Certificate of Registration issued by the Canadian Partbred Register, or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for, and must be entered under their full registered name.

A legible copy of the entire registration papers showing proof of ownership for each horse entered in the show must be submitted with the entry form. In the case of a contract of sale or lease, it is required that a copy of the sale contract or lease (containing registered name and number of the horse, date and signature of the seller or lessor) be submitted with a copy of the registration papers.

RING PROCEDURE - Towels, Whips & Other Objects. Once an animal is being exhibited in the show ring, there will be no objects of any nature, e.g., towels, whips, treats, etc., passed or transferred from a person on the rail to any exhibitor inside the show ring.

TRAIL FEE - An equipment fee of \$25 is required for all Trail participants. **The trail obstacles will remain up for schooling and trail** participants who have paid this fee will have access to the trail courses throughout the show.

TWO MINUTE RULE - Due to a full schedule of classes the TWO-MINUTE limit after last call for a class will be strictly enforced. Exhibitors are cautioned against entering the same horse in successive classes. The gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring or in cases with large classes taking more than 2 minutes at the completion of final horse in the continuous string of horses. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR TO BE SURE THAT HIS/HER HORSE IS AT THE GATE ON TIME. CLASS CALLS MUST BE CONSIDERED A COURTESY ONLY. No protests will be upheld on the basis of a public address system malfunction. "Open" cards may be run for Trail classes to assist exhibitors who might have a conflict with classes in another arena. Check with show manager or in the show office for details.

TBA - Region 1 has allotted space for TBA classes in the Pre-Show and TBA classes in the Regional Show. TBA classes may be any class on the AHA class list or that is recognized by AHA with the exception of dressage, cutting, reined cow, hunter/jumper. These classes may be placed throughout the schedule. Pre-show TBA Fee is \$100/class plus the class entry fee. Regional TBA Fee is \$200/class plus class entry. If TBA classes have 5 or more entries the TBA fee will be refunded to the requestor. TBAs are given on a first come first served basis only and must be reserved by May 27, 2025 with the show secretary. TBAs cannot be age split classes.

The official Rule Book of US Equestrian will prevail for this show. This Prize List is based on rules of the current Rule Book; any changes or corrections of rules will automatically become a part of the Prize List. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules.

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Questions not covered by USEF Rules shall be decided by the Show Committee and its decision will be final.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

USEF SAFE SPORT STATEMENT - All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies

USEF AMATEUR CERTIFICATION FOR EC AMATEUR MEMBERS - EC amateur members, competing in amateur classes, must complete and sign a USEF membership application verifying they meet USEF amateur requirements. There is no charge.

NEW AMATEUR/OWNER RULE - Combined ownership is permitted in Owner's or Amateur Owner's classes. PLEASE SEE THE usef rule book rule — AR110.4.e

USEF MEMBERSHIP - Affidavits are no longer accepted for payment of non-member fees. Exhibitors must have a Competing Membership, either Life, Senior Active or Junior Active Member or pay a Show Pass Fee. See next paragraph.

USEF NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION - If membership documentation is not submitted to the competition and the competition cannot verify such information, the exhibitor will be required to complete a Show Pass form and pay a non-refundable Show Pass fee of \$45.00. (GR1309.2.b) Show passes must be purchased online at USEF.org. A Show Pass is only valid for one competition and non-member participants (riders, drivers, handlers, vaulters, longeurs, owners, lessees, and agents) are limited to obtaining no more than one (1) Show Pass per competition year.

WDAA Membership Statement

To be eligible to participate and/or compete as an exhibitor, owner, lessee, agent, coach, or trainer in any Federation-Licensed Western Dressage class or competition, persons must be active members of WDAA or pay a non-member fee equal to the price of an annual membership for each competition. Exception: WDAA membership or non-member fee is not required at a Life Licensed competition. Lessees are considered owners in connection with this membership requirement. In the event of an entry under multiple ownership, only one owner need be a member or pay a non-member fee. The competition is responsible for listing either the active member or the owner that paid the non-member fee in the results. The competitions will be responsible for forwarding a list of the names of individuals who pay non-member fees at the competition to WDAA with the post competition report. Payment of non-member fees for the purpose of competing does not entitle the individual to any privileges of the WDAA membership.

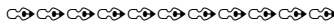

USDF Statement on Animal Welfare

The United States Dressage Federation, Inc. (USDF), a federation of over 100 independent organizations throughout the United States with a membership of nearly 30,000 members, supports the concept of ethical treatment of animals.

Dressage is a classical method of training horses, based upon the horse's natural responses, as carried out in a gradual, planned program during which the horse's athletic abilities are improved in a systematic manner. As a result, the horse becomes capable, comfortable, and responsive in partnership with the rider without the use of force. Dressage competition at various levels of achievement is the ultimate test of the training program to determine whether the desired harmony between horse and rider has been achieved.

The rules pertaining to dressage competition prohibit the use of artificial appliances, training aids, and drugs, which would force the horse to submit. Instead, the emphasis is upon training and a cooperative partnership with the rider. Major competitions are carefully monitored to assure that there is no unnecessary force or harshness displayed.

Unlike other horse sports in which horses enter training at a relatively immature state, dressage training is usually not seriously begun until the horse is three or four. The top levels of achievement require five or more years of progressive training and it is not unusual to see horses in international competition in their late teens. This, in itself, places a premium on good care and soundness throughout the horse's life.

While supporting the concept of animal welfare in its broadest form, the United States Dressage Federation, Inc., also recognizes that it is unrealistic to ascribe human emotions and responses to the horse which in its wild state is a creature of flight, living a hard and precarious existence. Under domestication, the horse is assured of ample food, water, and shelter, as well as protection against infectious diseases and damaging parasites, thus leading a longer and healthier life with a high rate of survival.

As an educational organization, USDF has numerous programs, which teach people how to pursue the accepted, humane training methods. A program of certifying instructors also emphasizes protecting the horse's welfare in pursuit of dressage training.

USDF Membership Benefits: USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the *USDF Member Guide* or the USDF website at www.usdf.org.

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$100), 5-years (\$400), or life (\$2,000). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$80). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards Program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$280) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$55 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$45). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded but will NOT be counted towards Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$95. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$140) is eligible for Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- On the USDF website: www.usdf.org. You can submit the application online or download the form.
- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.

Dressage

All dressage classes are open to Arabian, Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian horses.

Current Dressage tests will be ridden. Riders will be notified of their ride times prior to the show.

Please Note - Dressage classes may not be run in class order

NOTE - NO POST ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED IN DRESSAGE CLASSES.

Dressage ride times will be given on a first come first served basis.
