

Director's Message

From Kathy Callahan-Smith



Youth Nationals and Mid-Summer Nationals was a huge success again this year. With an increase to approximately 1,400 horses and over 4,900 total class entries. A Ranch Horse Clinic for the Youth was given prior to the show and was well attended. Discussions are currently under way for future plans for MSN in 2022.

Canadian Nationals has made an announcement they will be going forward with plans for 2022.

The USEF Amateur Task Force is still working on several ideas for simplifying and presenting some Amateur rule changes. These ideas will be brought forward in the near future.

One of the biggest discussions this year has been AHA Qualification changes for 2022. In my requests for Region One member opinions concerning Qualifications, everyone that has contacted me, was in favor of some type of qualification requirements. At the August meeting, the AHA BOD passed a compromise proposal to ensure some qualifications for Regionals and Nationals, yet allowing open boarders for lots of Regional participation. 2021 Horse Show placings and Top Fives will count towards 2022 qualifications. Specialty classes will have some modifications coming to accommodate the lack of classes available at most Arabian Horse shows. Details will be coming out soon. If you have any questions, feel free to contact me. Communication is the key.

The Distance Horse National Championships will be hosted by AHA and held in Big South Fork Site in Oneida, TN, September 9-12, 2021. This event is partnered with other breeds and open to all. A great opportunity to see Arabian Horses shine!

Leveling for Equitation and Showmanship was passed. These classes will also be split off from Pleasure performance leveling.

The Arabian Horse Foundation reported giving out \$85,000 in general scholarships, \$17,000 at Youth Nationals and \$5,000 for Youth of the Year. They want to thank the Regions and AHA Membership for the support.

We are in a changing world, especially post Pandemic. With the shows coming up, let's look into developing some fun ideas for all our horse shows. Examples for Region One Show; shorter show sessions for more social time, a Pro/Am for Charity class, Paper Race, Egg & Spoon.

Region I Arabian Horse Association Meeting Minutes 3-20-21

Call to order: At 6:15 PM

Roll Call: was confirmed by those in attendance on the Zoom conference call

Minutes: No Corrections. Debbie Price made a motion to approve the minutes from the Nov 19, 2020 meeting. – Laurie Henkle made the 2nd, Minutes were approved by attendees

Director's Report – Kathy submitted her Directors report via email previous to the meeting and recapped it during the meeting:

The AHA BOD met via Zoom on March 5th, 2021. The new AHA President, Deborah Johnson, did a great job presiding over the meeting.

The first topic of discussion was the Ransomeware attack on the Windows servers at AHA that occurred on Saturday, February 20, 2021, and the Website and Data Source were immediately taken offline. The AHA IT acted quickly and the system was returned to service on Monday, March 1, 2021.

We are still under the cloud of Covid, but the future looks brighter than 2020. All AHA Regional Championships are expected to be held. Mid-Summer Nationals will be held with Youth Nationals again this year, July 15-24, 2021. Canadian Nationals will not be held, although they hope to hold a smaller version for the Canadians to attend.

2021 Qualifications have been waived again for Regional and National Championship Shows. Qualifications for 2022 and 2023 will move to a "Participation" based system and the chart will be finalized at the August 2021 Board of Directors meeting.

The new USEF President, Tom O'Mara, joined us on the meeting. His outlook was positive and he is looking forward to addressing the needs of the Arabian Horse.

A new USEF Amateur Committee has been initiated. This committee hopes to simplify our current USEF amateur rules.

Information was presented and discussions held, concerning the appointment of an Executive Director for AHA. It was a unanimous decision of the Board of Directors to appoint Stan Morey as the Executive Director with a three-year contact. Mr. Morey will continue to serve as the Judges and Stewards Commissioner until that position is filled later this year.

The AHA Local Level Committee is asking for members to help execute the projects they have in the works for 2021. The ideal committee member is passionate about the Arabian horse, enjoys sharing Arabian horses with new people, will attend monthly calls, and is willing to take a leadership role on Local Level projects. The Local Level Committee's Mission: "To bring people to the Arabian horse through local outreach."

Our volunteer base is our most valuable asset. Let's do everything we can to encourage our Region One membership base to get involved.

In Addition to the written report above, Kathy asked the attendees for feedback on the Recovery fee that AHA has moved forward with for 2021 Regional shows. It will be \$15 this year, a reduction from the \$25 that was put in place for 2020. The general consensus from the attendees was that everyone was agreeable to the \$15 and felt it was better than the \$25 of last year.

Kathy also reported that AHA has implemented the Virtual show concept. Janet Henderson will be the judge for any sport horse related shows and Kathy will judge the others. The cost is \$25 to be judged and placed and \$35 if you want to receive a critique back.

Treasurer's Report: Given by Ann Whitley – Report filed for audit. Ann also presented the 2021 Budget. MaryAnn made a motion to accept the 2021 Budget as presented, 2nd by Mimi, 2021 Budget was approved.

Horse Show Report – by Kathy Callahan-Smith –

- We are still in need of volunteers, specifically for the In/out gate.
- The Security and restroom cleaning, due to the fairgrounds reduce staff/COVID requirements at the fairgrounds, will be a large expense that the show normally doesn't have. We will need to watch other expenses closely.
- It is still not known if the parking passes are needed. Mimi will need to have them printed prior to sending out the staff packets, if they are needed. Mimi to give Kathy a heads up on the timing so a decision can be made timely.
- Nancy has created a website to enable a virtual office at the horse show. This will eliminate the need for people to come into the office.

- A new Overall Sport Horse Award for the Pacific Slope classes will be implemented at the AHANC show, Sponsored by AHPC. Champion will receive prize money, a prize and ribbon, Reserve Champion will receive prize money and ribbon.
- The Dressage committee is working on a resolution for Western Dressage to allow braided manes. The WD chapter is silent on any restrictions to manes and at the AHA shows there is a lot of cross-entering and the general feeling is we should not restrict it either and follow the intent of the WD chapter.


